

## GRAND-PARENTING *into* CPSP Credentials

The College of Pastoral Supervision respects and values the clinical credentials of those certified by our colleagues in other major clinical pastoral certifying organizations such as: Association for Clinical Pastoral Education, American Association of Pastoral Counselors and Association for Professional Chaplains. It is possible for those credentialed and in good standing with these organizations to be grand-parented into CPSP and receive equivalent CPSP credentials.

The process includes the chapter making a determination that the candidate meets or exceeds both CPSP Standards and the Standards of the certifying body relative to the credential sought by the candidate in order to be considered for grand-parenting.

The Chapter is to complete the data form below and submit it to the appropriate Regional Certification Team Representative. The Certification Team will review and act on the Chapter's recommendation and report back to the Chapter.
